2 The said deceased left a will bearing date the twenty first day
of April one thousand eight hundred and ninety which is as we believe
the last will and Testament of the said deceased and which is unrevoked
as we believe

3 By his said will the said Testator appointed us these deponents
the said Richard James Clark (therein erroneously called James
Clark) and Oliver Henry Potts Executors thereof

4 The paperwriting hereunto annexed marked with the letter C^A
is the said last will of the said deceased as I verily believe

5 The said will was executed in the presence of Samuel Thorlock of
Frankston aforesaid Quaker and John Thompson of Frankston aforesaid Gentleman

The said deceased left real Estate in the Colony of Victoria not
Exceeding in value the sum of One thousand four hundred and fifty Eight pounds five shillings and
personal property in the said Colony not exceeding in value the sum of Seven
hundred and fifty seven pounds and two pence

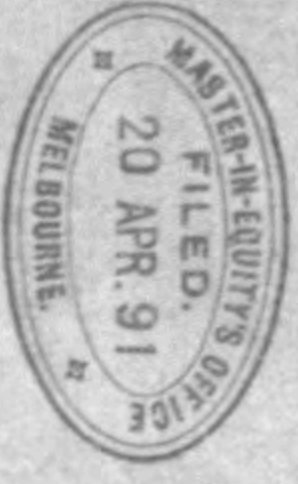
