got the opportunity, so I think that is why I liked  
my hair to look nice.

Peter Barsey at the R.S.I. dance at Wanaquel

We went together for 5 years, and married on 16.3.1968. We lived in Wynong for 4 years, behind the butcher shop. We moved to Drouen with Darren 4 yrs & Natalie 2 yrs. Then we had Rohan & Kelvin, where we have lived for 45 yrs. During the time that the children were at school, I did housecleaning & ironing.

In 1995 my sister Barbara & I went to America to visit my niece Joanne, who was a nannie over there.

When I came home from U.S.A, Peter & I drove over to Perth (Western Australia) where our grandson "Jake" was born 11/11/1995.

On Christmas Day 1997 our beautiful 12 years old son, Kelvin we lost in a road accident. Some things you never get over.

I have only cried with joy twice in my life, when Sydney Lewis, Lachlan & my team won the grand final in 2003. By the way Lachlan's birthday 24<sup>th</sup> June, the same day as Kelvin's, which is lovely. The other time I cried for joy was when "Bethany Elaine" was born.

I love the Royal Family (British) & I have my views on politics, & would have my say. I never liked to be away from home, when any of our children, or grandchildren's birthdays.

Of a Sunday I would watch "Insiders"

on channel 2, then Andrew Bolt on channel 10. After that we would go out for the day. I love photography mainly of my family & friends. I had photo albums of my children, & now photo albums of my grandchildren. I always have my camera in my handbag. We have 9 beautiful grandchildren, Chaddison, Jake, Thomas, Matthew, Justin, Lachlan, Leth, Daniel & Bethany.

In 2006 I was diagnosed with breast cancer, I had a mastectomy.

Peter & I went on "The Guan" to Darwin then in 2011 we went to New Zealand, which is a very clean country, no graffiti. I went on a cruise with some of the Brandy Creek Dawn Club girls, we had a great time.

Then in 2014 Peter & I went to England, Ireland & Scotland, back where our ancestors came from. We had many trips in our caravan, which we enjoyed.

I joined the Brandy Creek Dawn Club, a club where you lose weight naturally. In the first year I reached my goal weight (D's aim) I lost 14 kg's in 12 months, & in that year I became princess of the Club.
