On 26 Mar 44 enemy approximately 50 strong attacked for 5 hours a defensive position, held by approximately 1 platoon of 58/59 Aust Inf Bn. The enemy were armed with MG's, Mortars and Rifles. Cpl TREMELLEN, whose section bore the brunt of the attack set an inspiring example of coolness under fire. When the situation was critical he moved from one weapon pit to another over open ground and spurred his men on to greater efforts. When a Bren Gun had to be moved to a new position to repel a fresh attack he moved across a skyline under heavy fire to obtain it. Whilst moving back with the Bren in his left hand and two magazines in the right, a Jap who had penetrated our defences attacked him. With great presence of mind, having no time to fire at him, he knocked the Jap down with the magazines and then killed him with the Bren Gun. On several occasions during the night, Cpl TREMELLEN moved alone out of the perimeter to investigate noises in the scrub which might have indicated enemy preparation for a fresh attack. 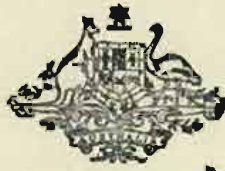
